Greetings to all of you working with Ola and me on the mission field of Thailand in South-east Asia for lo, these nigh on 52 years. Again, I refer to our daily Bible reading program of 3 chapters a day and 5 on Sundays. We finished our 2012 reading about December 25th and began anew January 1st, 2013. When I write these reports I like to give some scripture that we have read that month that relates to our need and value of carrying out the Great Commission here in a foreign land with a foreign language, THAILAND-- --Rev. 20:12-15. "And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God: and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they judged every man according to their works. 14. and death and hell were cast into the lake of fire.
