


Dorsey Traw Mission Report

I Cor. 3:9, "For we are laborers together with God". A pictorial report. 2014 begins our 22nd year in teaching the Karen tribes.




Picture # 1, and map

The 5th Karen Tribe church building opened January, 2014-at Mae Ngow Village which is located on the Tak and Mae Hong Sorn Province line. Many Christians from the area attended the opening service.

Brother Anuwat became a Christian in the year 2000 at the Chiang Mai Bible School. He has preached in the Mae Gnao Village area for five years. His wife is a day-care teacher and they have 2 children. Three former Karen Bible School students are now full time preachers.

In 1992-93 the Banaglang Karen church building was completed. It is the OLDEST congregation and is a five hour drive through the hills from Chiang Mai. Brother Jerupa was the first to become a Christian in Bannaglang.

2. Maejumsam
3. Maethia
4. Mae Gopi
5. Mae Ngao

Brother Jerern standing at my right at the new year's fellowship is a 1993 graduate of CBS. He works at the Health Department in Mae Jam town and worships with his family. Brother Jarupa, who is standing between Dorsey and Ola started our evangelization of the Karen mountain tribe. His history follows-when younger he lost his eyesight. But had others read various Bible lessons to him. After studying 3 Bible Correspondent Courses from Bangkok Church of Christ he requested baptism. When his

letter was forwarded to me, the first of many 5 hour trips in a rented Jeep ended in 11 being baptized. Brother Jarupa later came to study in Chiang Mai at CBS and to study Braille. Upon his return to Banaglang village he began to preach there.

Beloved Fellow-laborers in Thailand, As many of you know, we are coming nearer to the end of our journey in Thailand. After fifty-two years in the mission field, we are discovering that planning our transition back to the United States is a little more difficult than we initially thought. We have a plan in place to move by the spring of 2015 instead of the mid-year time frame which was initially announced. Recently, with the new budget year, we learned that some churches are moving their contribution to other good works since our contribution will soon be done in Thailand. So, how can you help? First of all, please keep us in your prayers. Our Lord is mighty and loving towards those who put on Christ. Secondly, we ask that you evaluate your current budget and consider increasing your contribution a little more each month to cover to cover the \$800.00 that we lost on January 1, 2014. This difference will help us as we finalize details for our move. As always, we will try to keep you informed of our progress and our plans for this new event in our lives.
