

**Worship Service Changes** Thanks in large to the efforts of Dennis Larson new AV equipment has been received and installed. This will improve our livestreaming. Dennis has also been successful in connecting the new AV equipment to the Fellowship Hall projection system. Because of these improvements and what we have learned over the past couple of months with our attended worship services the elders plan on initiating Phase II starting **Sunday, July 12**. The full Phase II plan will be posted on the church's webpage. Here are the pertinent points:

1. All of the safety measures previously put in place will remain in place with the exception of the request to leave an empty parking space between vehicles.
2. Except for a couple of rows in the front of the auditorium that will remain marked for non-use all of the chairs previously marked for non-use have been removed from the auditorium. This should make it easier to identify available seating.
3. The desired maximum number of worshipers in the auditorium will remain at 75 for the present. **HOWEVER**, all other worshipers can be accommodated downstairs in the Fellowship Hall where the rows of seats have been arranged similar to that of the auditorium. The large screen can be easily viewed. Seats in the auditorium will be available on a first come, first served basis. All families/individuals are encouraged to continue to pre-register which will greatly help Skip Winans and others that are coordinating services.
4. Because of the additional 'social distancing' seating capacity we will be having only one English service on Sundays. That service will begin at 10:30 AM. This service will continue to be livestreamed at least through August.
5. There will continue to be a Spanish service at 1 pm in the Fellowship Hall.
6. **All** members that physically attend worship services are reminded of his/her responsibility to a) not attend if they or any member of their family have been exposed to anyone that has tested positive for Covid19 within the last 30 days or has any symptom related to Covid19 and b) wear a face mask.
7. Please arrive sufficient early so that you can maintain social distancing. The front door will be opened for you and hand sanitizer will be offered. Please go directly and find your seat.
8. Once the service has finished you will be dismissed by row/sections and are requested to promptly depart the building. Social distancing fellowship is encouraged once you are outside the building.
